Pronounced oh-coh-tee-yo, it looks like a clump of tall, radiating stems. These thorny stems burst into leaf within a couple days after a good summer thunderstorm. Scarlet flowers soon tip the branches. The ocotillo loses its leaves quickly when drought ensues.
