MOJAVE MOUND

Echinocereus triglochidiatus

Mojave mound cactus vies with hedgehog cactus as the showiest succulent in the California desert. Red fleshy tepals, elongated flowers and dense blossom arrays make for truly spectacular displays. It grows in mounds of 20 to 40 heads, blooming in May through June. It is found throughout Queen Valley in JTNP.
